Silverware Pocket Roll Instructions:

(Measurements for 5x7 hoop are in parentheses.)

2 pieces 7x11" fabric "

(6x8" for 5x7 hoop)

2 pieces of 6.5 x 11" fabric folded so they are 6.5 x 5.5"

(2 pieces of 6x10" folded to 6x5" for 5x7 hoop)

- 1 28" piece of ribbon folded in half.
- Hoop one layer of tearaway stabilizer.
- 2. Center one piece of fabric on top of hoop.

Stitch first color to secure and to stitch pocket placement outline.

Stitch second color (nose).

Stitch third color (cheeks).

Stitch fourth color (eyes).

Stitch fifth color (smile).

- 4. Place a folded piece of fabric on top of hooped stabilizer/fabric so folded edge of fabric is even with the horizontal pocket placement line.
- 5. Stitch sixth color (secures in place and stitches pocket dividers).
- 7. Stitch seventh color (ribbon placement line).
- 8. Place folded ribbon centered over ribbon placement line so approximately 1/2" of ribbon folded end extends to the right of the design and rest of ribbon is within the design.
- 9. Stitch the eighth color to secure in place. Fold ribbon and tape within the design so the edge does not cross the stitching outline and become sewn down in the next step.
- 10. Add second piece of folded fabric on top of hooped stabilizer/fabric, so folded edge is even with the top folded edge of first folded fabric.
- 11. Stitch ninth color to secure in place.

Cover entire design with a piece of fabric, FACE DOWN.

Stitch final color to secure.

- 12. Remove from hoop and remove stabilizer. Trim around perimeter of design leaving approximately 1/4" seam allowance and clipping corners.
- 13. Turn inside out. Flip large pocket to back of design.

Insert napkin into pocket and silverware into small pockets and tie.
