

Piggie Instructions:

1. Hoop one layer of stabilizer.

Center a 5x5" piece of felt on top of stabilizer.

Stitch first color (pig outline).

2. Stitch second color (facial features).

Stitch third color (nostrils).

Stitch fourth color (overalls).

3. Float a second piece of felt under design, covering completely.

Stitch final color (softie outline).

4. Remove from hoop. DO NOT TRIM YET (this will make sewing the seam closed easy).

Stuff bear lightly with polyfil.

Sew the small opening closed by machine.

Trim around perimeter of pig.

You're finished!

Mama Pig Instructions:

1. Hoop one layer of stabilizer.

Center a 5x5" piece of felt on top of stabilizer.

Stitch first color (pig outline, nose, cheeks).

2. Stitch second color (facial features).

Stitch third color (nostrils).

Stitch fourth color (pearls).

3. Float a second piece of felt under design, covering completely.

Stitch final color (softie outline).

4. Remove from hoop. DO NOT TRIM YET (this will make sewing the seam closed easy).

Stuff pig lightly with polyfil.

Sew the small opening closed by machine.

Trim around perimeter of pig.

You're finished!

Big Bad Wolf Instructions:

1. Hoop one layer of stabilizer.

Center a 6x6" piece of felt on top of stabilizer.

Stitch first color (softie outline).

2. Stitch second color (facial features).

3. Float a second piece of felt under design, covering completely.

Stitch final color (softie outline).

4. Remove from hoop. DO NOT TRIM YET (this will make sewing the seam closed easy).

Stuff softie lightly with polyfil.

Sew the small opening closed by machine.

Trim around perimeter of softie.

You're finished!

3 Pigs Playset Instructions:

1. Hoop one layer of stabilizer.

Stitch first color (playset outline and ribbon strap placement line).

Cut a 10" piece of ribbon for strap.

Place loop centered over left hand placement line so approximately 1/2" of cut ribbon end extend below ribbon placement line and remainder of ribbon loop is OUTSIDE design area.

Stitch second color to secure.

Repeat with other end of ribbon on right hand side.

Stitch third color to secure.

2. Cover design completely with a 6x8" piece of felt.

Stitch fourth color to secure.

3. Stitch fifth color (brick house fabric placement outline).

Cover completely with a piece of fabric.

Stitch sixth color to secure.

Cut a 5x8" piece of fabric and fold in half and press so it is 5 x 4". Place folded fabric on top of pocket outline so folded edge is even with top straight horizontal edge of pocket outline and entire pocket below is completely covered.

Stitch seventh color to secure.

Trim both pocket and house fabric as closely to bed pocket stitching as possible being careful not to cut stitching or felt underneath.

Stitch eighth color (brick house satin stitching).

Stitch ninth color (straw house fabric placement outline).

Cover completely with a piece of fabric.

Stitch tenth color to secure.

Cut a 5x8" piece of fabric and fold in half and press so it is 5 x 4". Place folded fabric on top of pocket outline so folded edge is even with top straight horizontal edge of pocket outline and entire pocket below is completely covered.

Stitch 11th color to secure.

Trim both pocket and house fabric as closely to bed pocket stitching as possible being careful not to cut stitching or felt underneath.

Stitch 12th color (straw house satin stitching).

Stitch 13th color (stick house fabric placement outline).

Cover completely with a piece of fabric.

Stitch 14th color to secure.

Cut a 5x8" piece of fabric and fold in half and press so it is 5 x 4". Place folded fabric on top of pocket outline so folded edge is even with top straight horizontal edge of pocket outline and entire pocket below is completely covered.

Stitch 15th color to secure.

Trim both pocket and house fabric as closely to bed pocket stitching as possible being careful not to cut stitching or felt underneath.

Stitch 16th color (stick house satin stitching).

4. Float a 6x8" piece of felt UNDER hooped design, FACE DOWN.

Float a 4x8" piece of felt UNDER felt piece just placed so that the top horizontal edge is in the middle of design to create a large back pocket.

Stitch final color to secure.

Remove from hoop and trim around perimeter of 3 Pigs playset carrier outline being careful not to cut ribbon strap (I cut one layer at a time).

Insert characters into pocket.

You're finished!
